

## Social Sport Policies and Code of Conduct

The Social Sport Policies and Code of Conduct are to assist in the enjoyment of your game, the smooth running of your competition and to protect the reliable majority. It is important that you read and understand the Policies and the Code of Conduct to enjoy the season to the fullest.

### Policies

#### 1. Forfeits

By providing the competition management less than 48 hours' notice is deemed to be a forfeit to your fixtured game. The penalty is **one full game fee** which is due on the same day as the scheduled game time and will result in a loss for that match and competition points.

#### 2. Safety

As the sports played at the Y Leisure City are of an 'Active' nature with moving equipment (balls, netting etc) and participants, all players must be aware that injuries/accidents may occur therefore participants play at their own risk. The Y Leisure City does its best to make your playing experience not only enjoyable, but also safe at the same time by providing safe equipment and facilities. We ask that you aren't reckless with the equipment or careless with your actions that could increase the risk of injury.

#### 3. Uniforms (Soccer/Indoor Football/Netball)

Matching tops (no singlets) are required with printed/sewn on individual numbers. Drawn on or taped on numbers will not be accepted. Bibs are available for hire (\$20). Incorrect uniforms may attract goal penalties. There is no uniform requirement for Beach Volleyball.

#### 4. Game Fees

Match fees are to be paid in full prior to the game via the TeamPay app. For more information regarding TeamPay, please see a member of staff.

## 5. Player registration

All players are required to be registered within a team and pay the \$15 registration fee per season. This fee covers competition administration, equipment and trophies for finals. This fee does **not** include player insurance.

## 6. Fill-in players

We understand that from time to time that fill-in players are required to field a team. If a fill-in player plays in a team on 2 or more occasions that are deemed to be regular player and will be required to be a registered player. If a fill-in player is a player from another team in the same competition – a one goal penalty will be applied.

## 7. Finals

Eligible players in finals matches must have played a minimum of 3 games and be a registered player.

### Code of conduct

While we understand that teams and individuals have different levels of passion and competitiveness, the purpose of our social sports is to promote enjoyment and the benefits of physical activity. Participants and spectators are required to conduct themselves in good spirits and a positive manner in accordance with our Code of Conduct.

Violations of the Code of Conduct will be subject to strict penalties, which may include immediate and in-game penalties, suspension and potentially immediate removal from the centre.

Teams are responsible for any spectator that is associated with their team and must make sure spectators follow the same guidelines as the players. Penalties may apply to teams for misconduct from spectators.

- The Y Leisure City enforces a NO tolerance rule to both physical and verbal violence towards staff and other patrons. The Centre reserves the right to remove anybody they feel is breaking this rule.
- Unacceptable, abusive, discriminative or threatening language toward any player, umpire, official, spectator or centre representative will not be tolerated on or off the court

- Players, officials, spectators under the influence of drugs or alcohol may be asked to leave the facility
- Players must agree to conduct themselves in a fair and appropriate manner at all times
- Without the referee/umpire, there wouldn't be a match so please respect their decisions and play in a fair manner.
